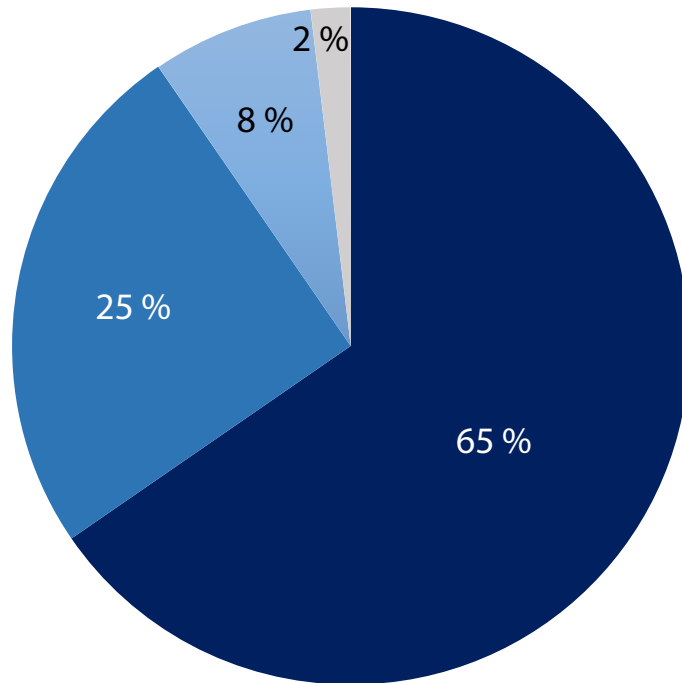

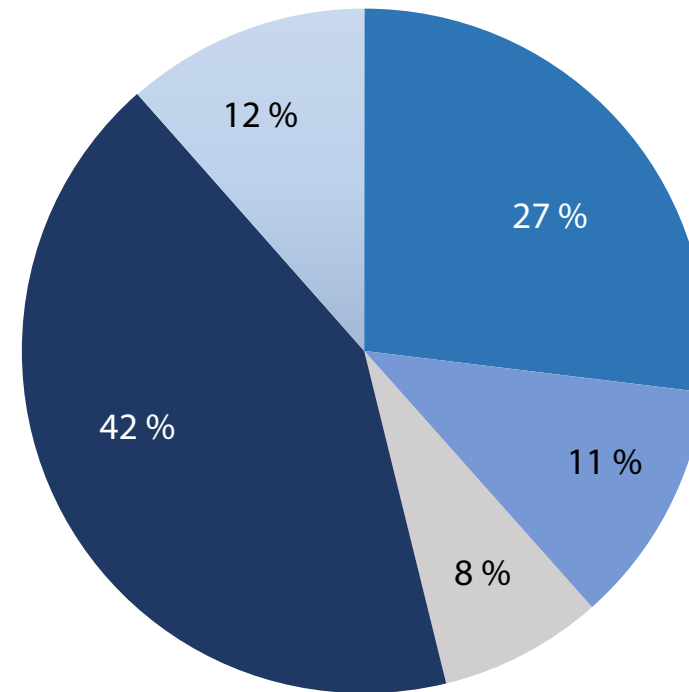

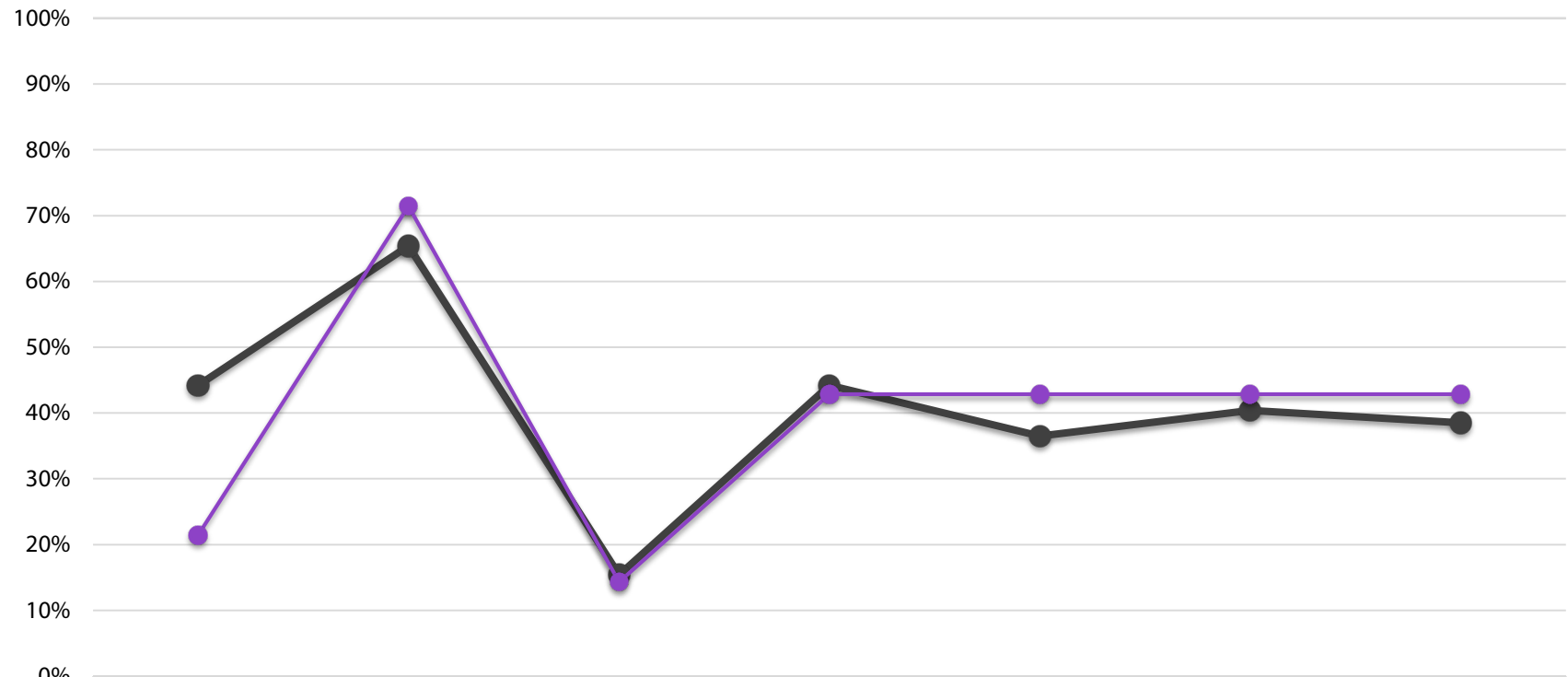

MOST VOTED OBJECTIVES FOR 2021-2027 TOTAL GROUP AND SOUTH KARELIA

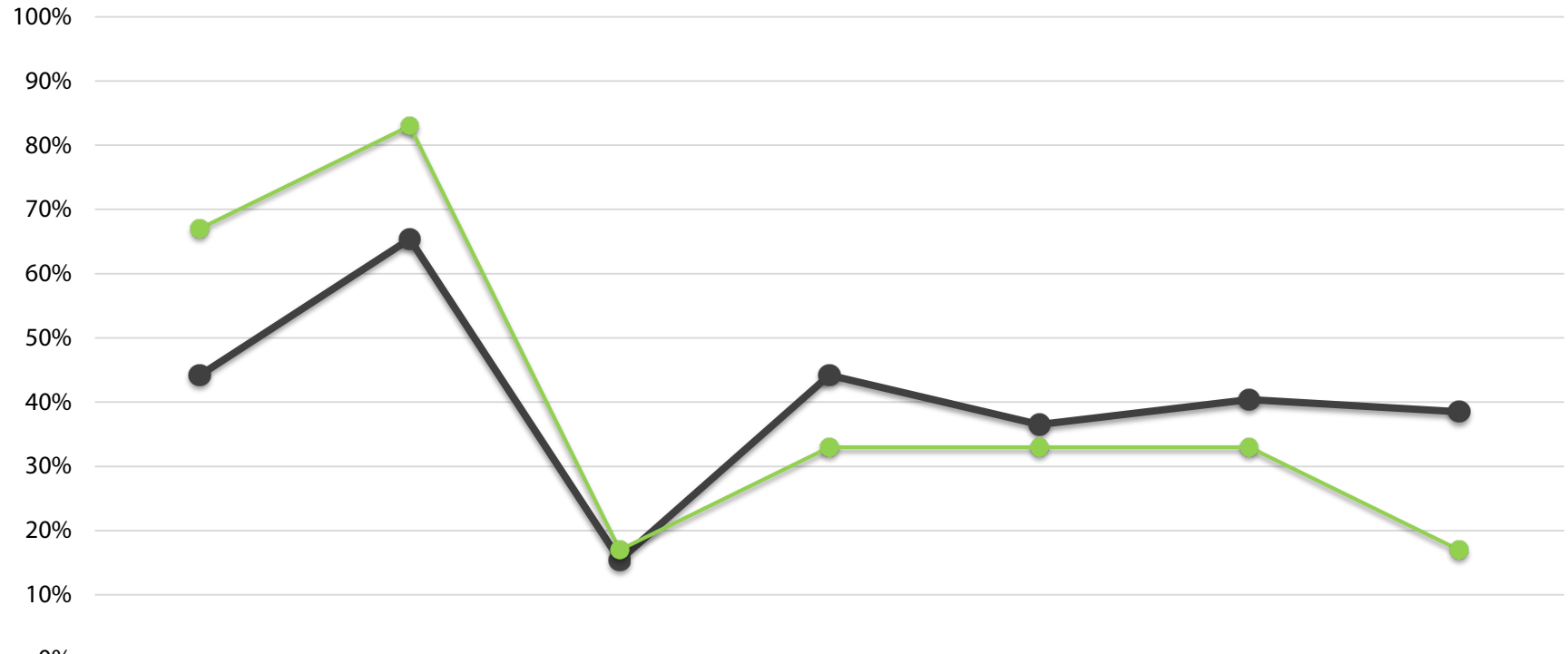

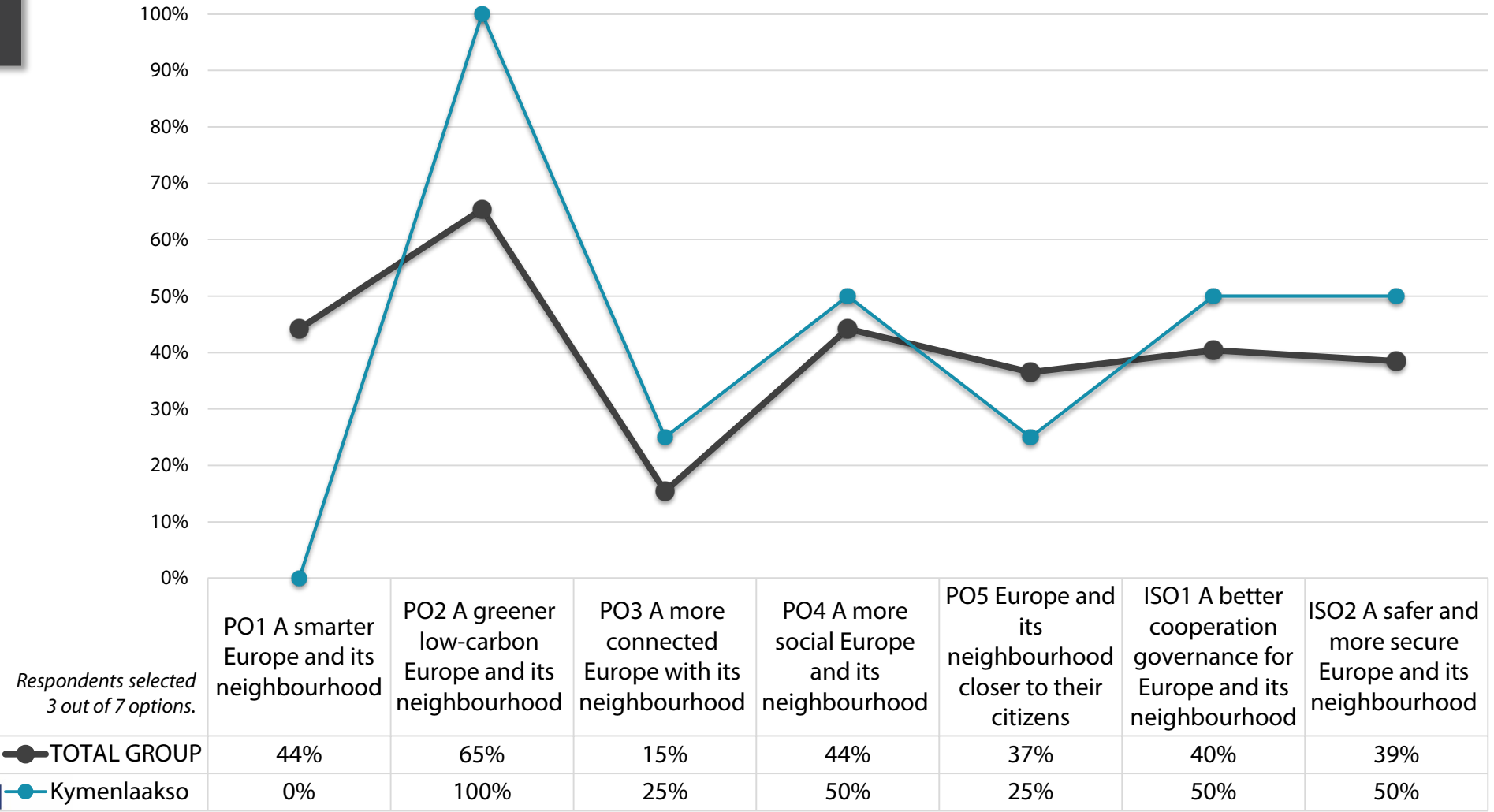

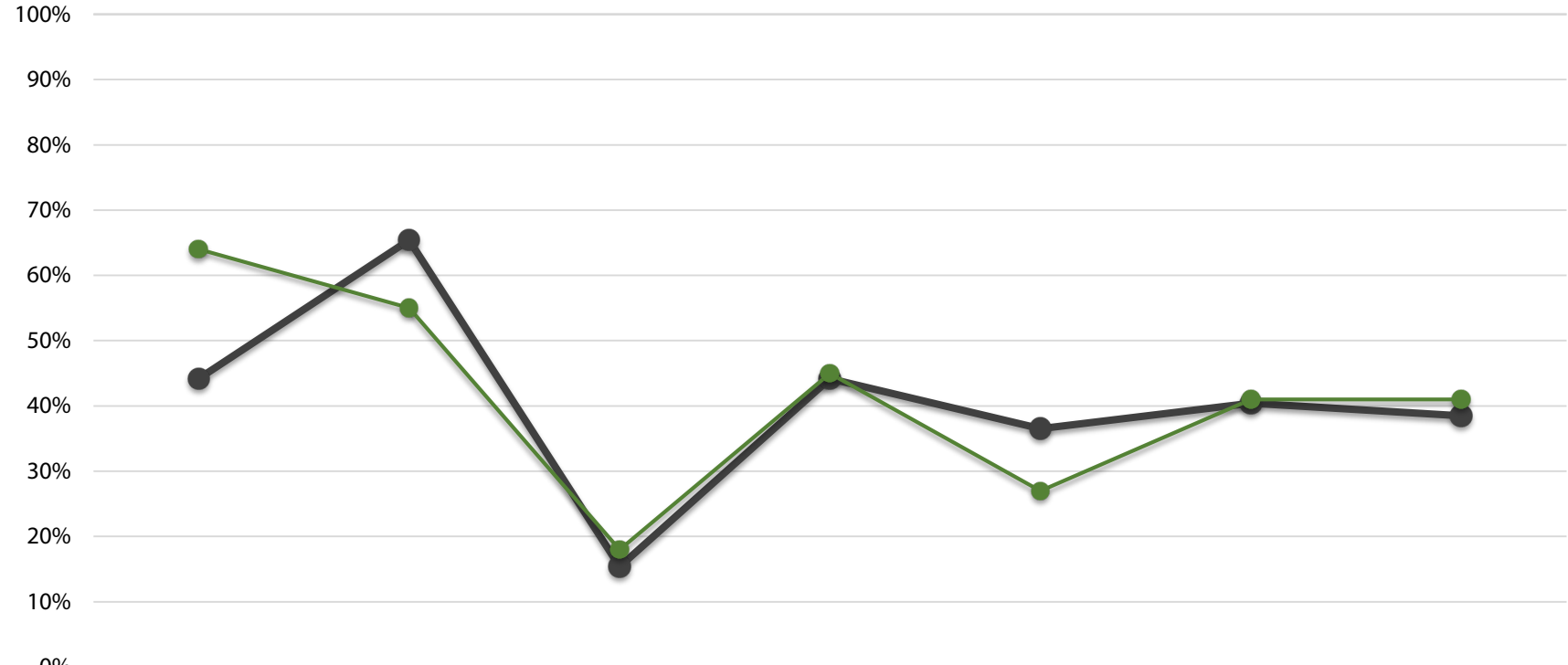
MOST VOTED OBJECTIVES FOR 2021-2027 TOTAL GROUP AND KYMENLAAKSO

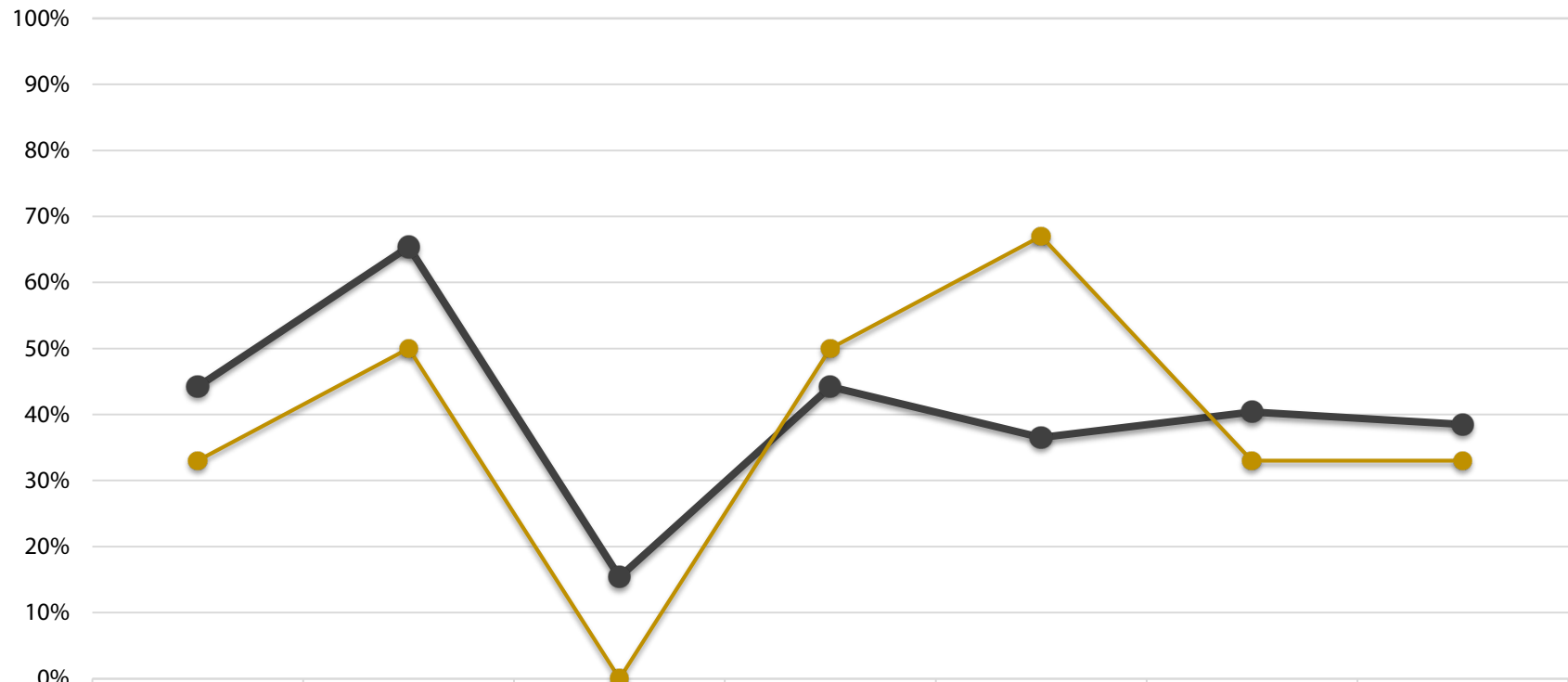

MOST VOTED OBJECTIVES FOR 2021-2027 TOTAL GROUP AND LENINGRAD REGION



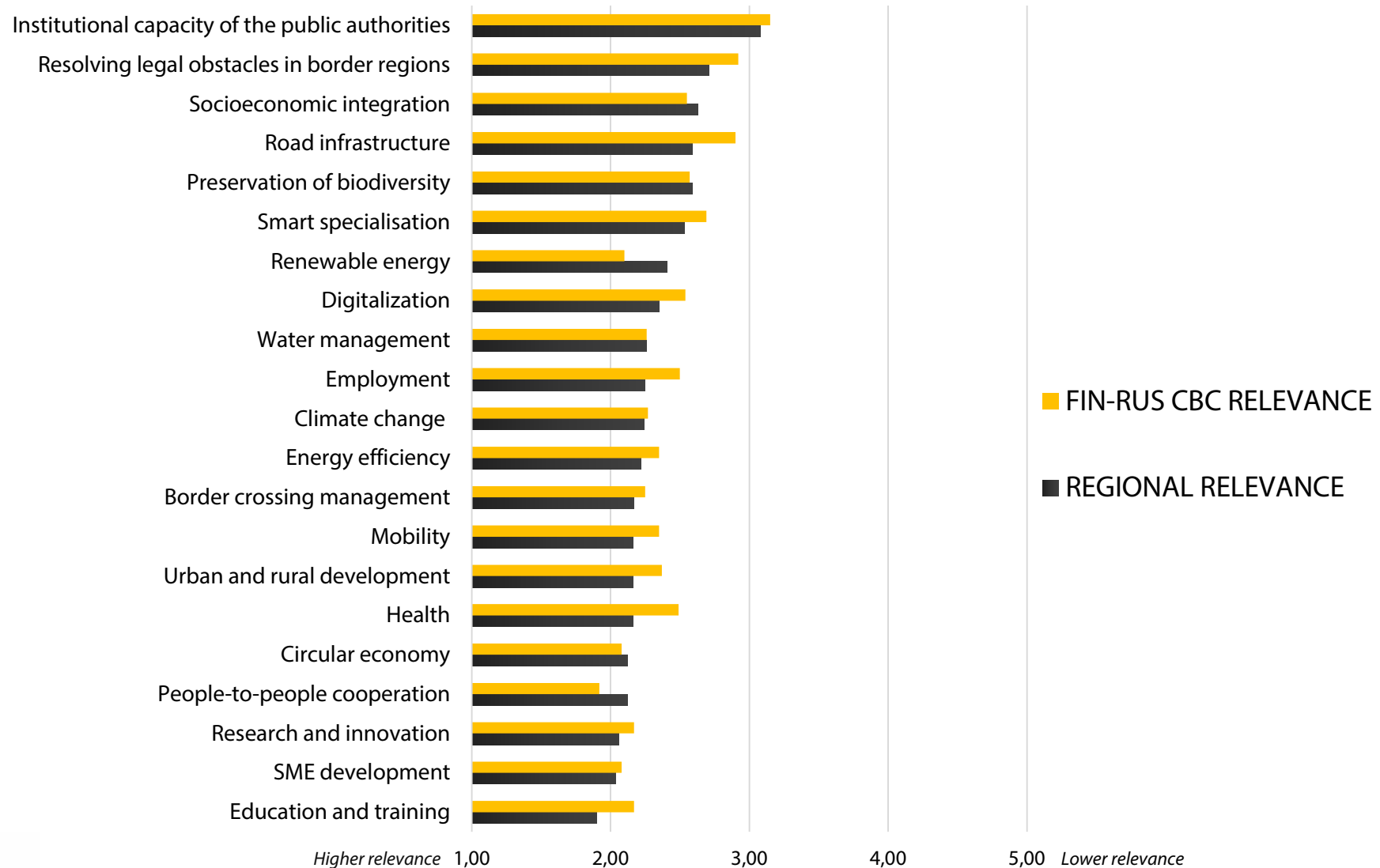
